

UNCLAIMED FUNDS INSTRUCTIONS

When the Trustee is unable to locate a debtor, creditor or an interested party, and that party is entitled to funds in the Trustee's possession, those funds are turned over to the clerk of the bankruptcy court, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §347(a) and F.R.B.P. 3011.

If you wish to claim funds that have been turned over to the clerk, you will need to file a "Motion for Order Releasing Unclaimed Funds." The form for the motion is available from the clerk of the court (Local Bankruptcy Rules form #3011-1) (see website, below).
